



# Stories of Hope, Paths to Progress



Sonalika CSR organized Eye Screening Camps across rural Rajasthan, reaching 25 villages and serving over 4000 individuals with free eye examinations. Offering affordable spectacles on-site, this initiative aims to raise awareness about common eye diseases and promote preventive healthcare.



The Kisan club of Sonalika CSR organised a meeting at Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Kannauj, engaging 43 male and female farmers. Led by senior scientists and District Coordinator Sandeep Kumar, the session covered agricultural activities from sowing to harvesting, addressing common crop diseases like virus-borne and fungal infections. Practical advice and medication kits were also provided.



The Saraswati Sonalika Umang Custom Hiring Center in Digsara, Kannauj, is run collaboratively by women with support from Umang Sunhara Kal Seva Samiti, and Sonalika CSR. The center has significantly lowered agricultural costs and boosted yields for local farmers by offering modern equipment like zero tillage machines and power sprayers.
